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Introduction

Overview:

This attractive hat and scarf set is made by alternating sections of garter stitch pattern rows with sections of twisted stockinette stitch rows. The garter stitch segments prevent curled ends and edges. Both the hat and scarf are made on the round loom.

The sample adult hat was knit on the round green Knifty Knitter loom using Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick and Quick yarn in color fisherman (640-099), and will fit most adult heads. Instructions are also given for a child's size hat made on the round red Knifty Knitter loom. The scarf was made on the round green Knifty Knitter loom by knitting back and forth on 15 pegs for a flat piece.

Skill Level: Easy

Materials Needed:

- Large gauge round knitting loom with 36 pegs, such as the round green Knifty Knitter loom (red KK loom for child's hat)
- Crochet hook size J or K
- Hook tool
- 3 skeins Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick and Quick yarn
- Scissors
- Tapestry needle

Knowledge Required:

- Crochet cast on (see notes below)
- Twisted stockinette (e-wrap) stitch
- Purl stitch
- Flat removal method (see notes below)
- Gathered removal method (see notes below)

Gauge: 9 stitches, 12 rows = 4"; exact gauge is not critical

Finished Size:

Adult Hat: 19" circumference, 8" long.

Child Hat: 14" circumference, 6" long.

Scarf: 6" wide, 52" long.

Notes:

- All knit stitches are twisted stockinette, made with the e-wrap stitch.
- The instructions for the scarf flat piece include a slipped stitch edge.
- Crochet Cast On:
 1. Make a slip knot 6" from the end of the yarn.
 2. Place the loop on peg 1.
 3. Insert the crochet hook through the loop that is on the peg.
 4. Catch the working yarn with the crochet hook, and pull it through the loop on the peg.
 5. Put the newly created loop onto the next peg.
 6. Repeat steps 3-5 until there is a loop on every peg.
 7. Repeat steps 3-5 once more, putting the new loop on peg 1. Knit off peg 1. When starting your first row of knitting, wrap peg 1 first.
- Gathered Removal Method:
 1. Cut a strand of yarn equal to 1-1/2 times the diameter of the loom. Thread the yarn on the tapestry needle.
 2. Put the needle through the loop on peg 1, from the bottom of the loop coming up.
 3. Repeat step 2 for all the loops, in sequence.
 4. Thread the needle through the loop on peg 1 again.
 5. Remove the loops from all the pegs.
 6. Turn the knitting inside out, making sure the yarn strands and the ending tail come to the wrong side of the knitting.
 7. Pull on both ends of the yarn strand to gather the knitting tight, and tie in a knot.
 8. Tie again, including the ending tail in the knot. Trim yarn ends 1/2" from the knot.
- Flat Removal Method:
 1. Put the loop on peg 2 onto peg 1.
 2. Knit off peg 1.
 3. Put the loop from peg 1 onto empty peg 2.
 4. Repeat steps 1 – 3 until there is one loop left on the loom.
 5. Secure yarn as directed in pattern.

Hat Directions:

Cast on using the crochet cast on method (see notes).

All sizes:

- Row 1: Knit all.
- Row 2: Purl all.
- Rows 3 – 6: Repeat rows 1 – 2 two times.
- Rows 7 – 10: Knit all.
- Row 11-16: Repeat rows 1-6.
- Rows 17 – 19: Knit all.

Adult size only:

- Repeat rows 1 – 8.

All sizes:

- Repeat rows 1 – 4.
- Next row: Move the loop on peg 1 to peg 2, the loop on peg 3 to peg 4, and so on. When done, there should be no loops on the odd numbered pegs, and two loops on the even numbered pegs. E-wrap the pegs with two loops, and knit off by bringing the bottom two loops over the top one loop and off the peg.

Remove the hat from the loom with the gathered bind off (see notes).

Weave in yarn tails.

Scarf Directions:

Garter section:

- Row 1: Knit pegs 14 – 1.
- Row 2: Purl pegs 2 – 14, e-wrap and knit off peg 15.
- Rows 3 – 10: Repeat rows 1 – 2 four times.

Knit section:

- Row 1: Knit pegs 14 – 1.
- Row 2: Knit pegs 2 – 15.
- Rows 3 – 6: Repeat rows 1 – 2 two times.

Cast on to 14 pegs using the crochet cast on method (see notes). Put the remaining loop on the crochet hook onto the 15th peg.

Work the garter section.

Work the knit section.

Continue alternating the garter and knit sections 11 more times.

Knit the garter section.

Remove the scarf from the loom with the flat bind off method. Weave in yarn tails.
